OPENING OF THE CHURCHES

At long last we are able to open the doors of our churches even if only for private prayer at the moment. The Holy Sacrifice of the Mass will continue to be offered privately as it has every day since the lockdown. The clergy are looking forward to the day when we will be able to congregate again – it has not been the same without you! Meanwhile, it is important that we follow the government regulations to keep everyone as safe as possible. Both churches will be open for one hour on alternate days of the week as a start and then we would hope to move to more availability but this depends on having enough people to supervise the openings and to sanitize the buildings after use.

- Saturday - 10.00am at Holy Family Church
- Sunday - 4.00pm at the Church of Our Lady of the Annunciation
